PURPOSE

To annex a 83.83 acre tract of land, lying contiguous to the City limits, into the City of Shreveport. This proposed ordinance will have direct impact on Council District "D".

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The City of Shreveport received a request from Raley and Associates Engineering to annex a 83.83 acre tract of land, which lies east of Wallace Lake Road and north of Southern Trace Parkway which will be developed into a residential subdivision known as St. Andrews Place. This annexation will allow the developer to construct 52 homes. The developer will be responsible for installing all water lines, sewer lines, storm drainage, and public streets that will be built to City specifications. This subdivision will provide additional tax revenues to the City as well as providing additional housing to the citizens of Shreveport.

WHEREAS, petitions signed by more than the required percentage in number of registered voters and in number of resident property owners and by more than the required percentage in property value of resident owners of the area described below have been filed with the City Council to annex and bring within the corporate limits of the City of Shreveport, Louisiana, the following described property, to wit:

TAG NO. 12-09 Description of a tract of land in section 30, Township 16 North, Range 13 West, Caddo Parish, Louisiana, said tract being more fully described as follows:

From a 3" diameter iron pipe being the northwest corner said section 30, run thence South 89°03'04" East a distance of 2404.09 feet to the east right-of-way line of Wallace Lake Road, thence run South 01°04'25" West along said right-of-way line a distance of 2859.29 feet to the point of beginning of the tract herein described.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Clerk of Council be and is hereby authorized to file, within ten (10) days of the final passage of this ordinance, with the Clerk of the District Court

for Caddo Parish a description of the entire boundary of the municipality as changed by this ordinance.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Clerk of Council be and is hereby authorized to record a certified copy of this ordinance in the official records of the District Court for Caddo Parish, Louisiana.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that if any provision or item of this ordinance or the

application thereof is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions, items, or

applications of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provisions, items, or

applications and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared severable.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all ordinances or resolutions or parts thereof in

conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
