## **PURPOSE**

To adopt the 2017 General Fund Budget, in accordance with State law and City Charter.

## **BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

The 2017 General Fund budget of \$210,168,100 indicates a 7.5% decrease from the 2016 budget.

The revenue and expenses of the city's solid waste operations have been moved to an enterprise fund to be self-sustained by a solid waste fee.

Projected Revenues: \$203,293,800; 9% decrease from the 2016 adopted budget. General Fund decrease is a result of a reduction in certificate of indebtedness proceeds for vehicles, and overall decreases in notes payable, materials, supplies, contractual services.

Projected Expenditures: \$201,323,800; 8% decrease from the 2016 adopted budget due to departmental cuts, offset by certificates of indebtedness and increases in insurance and retirement contributions. Overall, expenditures represent decreases in personal services, materials, and contractual services.

Projected Operating Reserves: \$8,844,300 which represents 4.4% of 2017 General Fund budget expenditures. The city's goal is to maintain reserves of at least 7% of expenditures.

WHEREAS, Article 7 of the Charter of the City of Shreveport requires the adoption of a comprehensive operating budget for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2017

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Shreveport, in legal session convened, that:

- 3. The General Fund Budget presented to the City Council by the Mayor by October 1, 2016 as amended by subsequent action of the City Council, be and the same is hereby adopted.
- 4. <u>Capital Transfers</u> All amounts authorized by the Capital Improvements Budget ordinance to be financed from General Fund receipts shall be transferred to the proper capital funds as provided in the Capital Improvements Budget ordinance.
- 5. <u>Administration</u> The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute all contracts, deeds, grant documents and other legal instruments necessary to expend and receive the funds herein authorized, excluding contracts for special legal counsel.
- 6. <u>City Court Judges' Salaries</u> The salary paid to each City Court judge by the City of Shreveport shall be \$89,600 per annum for the year 2017
- 7. <u>City Marshal's Salary</u> The salary paid to the City Marshal by the City of Shreveport shall be \$110,000 per annum for the year 2017.
- 8. <u>Donation of City Funds</u> The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute all contracts involving funds appropriated herein. However, prior to execution, all contracts in which the City undertakes obligations or responsibilities over and above payment of funds herein appropriated must be authorized in accordance with Section 26-53 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Shreveport, as it exists now or may hereafter be amended.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that if any provision or item of this ordinance or the application thereof is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions, items or applications of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provisions, items or applications; and to this end, the provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared severable.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all ordinances or parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this ordinance will be effective on January 1, 2017.
