
CITY OF SHREVEPORT CRIME SINCE 1970







Top 10 Citizen-Initiated Calls




Top 10 Officer-Initiated Calls



Top 10 Call Signals






TRAFFIC TICKETS




Traffic tickets for 2020 were significantly lower due to changes in operational procedures of the police department during the COVID-19 pandemic. Officers made fewer traffic stops during much of the year and wrote fewer tickets due to courts being closed and implementation of COVID-19 procedures to limit contact with Ticket Books and IDs for drivers. 2020 should be considered as an outlier year if ticket numbers are being compared to prior years.

VEHICLE CRASHES



SHREVEPORT EXPERIENCED OVER 9,000 MOTOR VEHICLE ACCIDENTS IN 2020 RESULTING IN 29 FATALITIES. OVER 4000 PEOPLE EXPERIENCED SOME TYPE OF INJURY DURING THESE CRASHES, AND OVER 800 PEOPLE EXPERIENCED A SERIOUS INJURY WITH SOME OF THOSE INJURIES RESULTING IN DEATH AS NOTED EARLIER. OVER 24,000 DRIVERS, PASSENGERS, AND PEDESTRIANS WERE INVOLVED IN THE ACCIDENTS. SEE THE CRASH MAP TO VIEW STREET SEGMENTS THAT HAD THE HIGHEST NUMBER OF ACCIDENTS.
