



# CITY OF SHREVEPORT CRIME SINCE 1970



# VIOLENT CRIME IN SHREVEPORT SINCE 1970


The 51-year average number of Violent Crimes per year is 1,747






### Top 10 Citizen-Initiated Calls

### Top 10 Call Signals








# VEHICLE CRASHES



Over 20,000 people were involved in over 9,000 vehicle accidents. See the map for areas with high numbers of reported crashes.




