Arrest Made in Domestic Stabbing Incident - Rodrenesha Burgy

On February 24, at approximately 9:55 a.m., Shreveport Police officers responded to an incident in the 1400 block of Highland Avenue. Upon arrival, officers discovered a male victim with stab wounds, indicative of a domestic altercation.

After an investigation, officers identified the suspect as Rodrenesha Burgy, 34 years of age. Burgy was promptly taken into custody and is now facing one count of domestic abuse battery with serious bodily injury.

Fortunately, the victim is currently in stable condition and is expected to make a full recovery.

The Shreveport Police Department urges anyone who is a victim of domestic violence or knows someone who may be a victim to seek help immediately. There are resources available, including shelters and hotlines, to provide support and assistance.

We are required to remind that all suspects are innocent until found guilty.
