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Convicted Felon Flees from Shreveport Police, Ends Up in Jail



On September 21st, 2024, at approximately 2:50 AM, officers with the Shreveport Police Department attempted to stop a vehicle driven by 24-year-old Christopher Beliew for multiple traffic violations. Beliew chose to flee in the vehicle, leading officers on a pursuit through the area.

The pursuit ended with Beliew's arrest, and during the investigation, officers discovered that he was in possession of a firearm. Beliew, a convicted felon, now faces a series of charges, including:

- Possession of Firearm/Carrying a Concealed Weapon by a Convicted Felon
- Resisting an Officer
- Aggravated Flight from an Officer
- Improper Lane Use
- Illegal Possession of Stolen Goods
- No Driver's License
- Hit & Run
- Illegal Possession of a Stolen Firearm

Beliew has been booked into the Shreveport City Jail, where he remains in custody.

Chief Wayne Smith would like to remind the public that the Shreveport Police Department is committed to removing firearms from the hands of those prohibited from possessing them, ensuring the safety of our community.
