Shreveport Police Make Arrests Following Suspicious Vehicle Call

In the early morning hours of January 5, officers with the Shreveport Police Department responded to the 1000 block of Marshall Street in reference to a suspicious vehicle.

Upon arrival, officers conducted an investigation that ultimately resulted in the arrest of Robert Cheatham and Quincy Thomas. Both individuals were charged with one count of obscenity.

Under Louisiana law, the crime of obscenity includes the intentional:

Exposure of the genitals, pubic hair, anus, vulva, or female breast nipples in any public place or place open to public view, or in any prison or jail, when done with the intent of arousing sexual desire, appealing to prurient interest, or in a manner that is patently offensive; or

Participation in or engagement in hard-core sexual conduct, including the production, presentation, performance, promotion, exhibition, advertisement, sponsorship, electronic communication, or display of such conduct, when it is determined that:

The average person applying contemporary community standards would find the conduct appeals to prurient interest,

The conduct is presented in a patently offensive way, and

The conduct, taken as a whole, lacks serious literary, artistic, political, or scientific value.

Both subjects were taken into custody without incident.

The Shreveport Police Department reminds the public that suspicious activity should be reported promptly and appreciates the community's continued cooperation in keeping neighborhoods safe.
