**ROADWORK IN SOUTH SHREVEPORT TO BEGIN MONDAY, FEBRUARY 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2026**


Monday, February 2nd, beginning at 8:00 am, the contractor for the City of Shreveport will close Norris Ferry Road between Ellerbe Road and Overton Brooks Road (Par Rd. 118) to thru traffic. Local traffic between Ellerbe Road and Stonehedge Dr. and Local traffic between Overton Brooks Rd. and Regency Blvd. will be permitted.

This work is scheduled for approximately 12 weeks. The closure is necessary to reconstruct the bridge, guardrails and ditches between Stonehedge Dr. and Regency Blvd. During this time, local traffic only will be allowed on Norris Ferry Road between Ellerbe Road and Overton Brooks Road (Par Rd. 118).

Southbound thru traffic on Norris Ferry Road will be required to utilize Ellerbe Road to Overton Brooks Road to detour back to Norris Ferry Road. Northbound thru traffic on Norris Ferry Road will be required to utilize Overton Brooks Road to Ellerbe Road to detour back to Norris Ferry Road. Please follow all signing and as always use caution in the work zone.
