Units Respond to Blaze at Jolie Apartments

Shreveport, LA – On Wednesday March 4, 2026 at 10:27 a.m. Shreveport Fire Department received calls for a report of an apartment fire in the 1000 block of Quail Creek.

Engine 5 arrived on scene and reported heavy smoke and flames from one of the large units inside the apartment complex. Crews immediately began a coordinated attack, quickly utilizing the 2 (two) water tanker trucks – one provided by Bossier City Fire Department – to supply hand lines for fire attack. Other units stretched supply lines across the levee to Reilly Lane before connecting to Truck 7 for aerial operations.

In total 19 units responded to the blaze before bringing the incident under control just before 11:00 a.m. The fire remains under investigation by Shreveport Arson Investigators. The Shreveport Fire Department would like to remind citizens that this complex is closed. As such there are no connected utilities and no one should be present inside the complex.

Additionally, Shreveport Fire Department would like to thank Bossier City Fire Department for use of their water tanker during this time, as well as the Shreveport Water & Sewer Department for their continued work to improve water conditions throughout the city over the previous week.
